The following Privacy Policy governs the online information collection practices of Jim Molinelli LLC (“we” or “us”). Specifically, it outlines the types of information that we gather about you while you are using Remodeling Success Blueprint or JimMolinelli.com (the “Site”), and the ways in which we use this information. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any information you may provide to us or that we may collect offline and/or through other means (for example, at a live event, via telephone, or through the mail).

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By visiting and using the Site, you agree that your use of our Site, and any dispute over privacy, is governed by our Terms and Conditions and this Privacy Policy and the United States laws that govern data collection and privacy.

Because the Web is an evolving medium, we may need to change our Privacy Policy at some point in the future, in which case we’ll post the changes to this Privacy Policy on this website and update the Effective Date of the policy to reflect the date of the changes. By continuing to use the Site after we post any such changes, you accept the Privacy Policy as modified.

This Site strives to offer its visitors the many advantages of Internet technology and to provide an interactive and personalized experience. We may use Personally Identifiable Information (such as your name, e-mail address, street address, telephone number) subject to the terms of this privacy policy. We will never sell, barter, or rent your email address to any unauthorized third party.

HOW WE COLLECT AND USE INFORMATION

We may collect and store personal or other information that you voluntarily supply to us online while using the Site. More specifically, we collect personally identifying information from our users during online registration and online purchasing. Generally, this information includes name and e-mail address for registration to receive our free offers, or name, postal address, and credit card information when purchasing our products. (e.g., while on the Site or in responding via email to a feature provided on the Site). This Site only contacts individuals who specifically request that we do so or in the event that they have signed up to receive our free offers or have purchased one of our products. All of this information is provided to us by you.

We also collect and store information that is generated automatically as you navigate online through the Site. For example, we may collect information about your computer's connection to the Internet, which allows us, among other things, to improve the delivery of our web pages to you and to measure traffic on the Site. We also may use a standard feature found in browser software called a "cookie" to enhance your experience with the Site. Cookies are small files that your web browser places on your hard drive for record-keeping purposes. By showing how and when visitors use the Site, cookies help us deliver advertisements, identify how many unique users visit us, and track user trends and patterns. They also prevent you from having to re-enter your preferences on certain areas of the Site where you may have entered preference information before. The Site also may use web beacons or pixels (single-pixel graphic files also known as "transparent GIFs") to access cookies and to count users who visit the Site or open HTML-formatted email messages.

We use the information we collect from you while you are using the Site in a variety of ways, including using the information to customize features. We also may provide your information to third parties, such as service providers and contractors, for a variety of purposes. (For example, if you register for a webinar, we would share your email with a third party application so that we can send you a link to attend the webinar.) If you do not wish us to install cookies or you don't agree with how we use cookies in any way, you can change the settings in your internet browser or delete or

choose not to accept cookies. Please be aware that if you delete or do not accept our cookies, some areas of the Site that you access may take more time to work, or may not function properly. For more information about cookies, please visit: <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>.

We will not disclose to third parties, any information collected from and about you while you are using the Site in any way and for any purpose. Please keep in mind that whenever you voluntarily make your personal information available for viewing by third parties online — for example on message boards, web logs, through email, or in chat areas — that information can be seen, collected and used by others besides us. We cannot be responsible for any unauthorized third-party use of such information.

The Site also includes links to other websites and provides access to products and services offered by third parties, whose privacy policies we do not control. When you access another website or purchase third-party products or services through the Site, use of any information you provide is governed by the privacy policy of the operator of the site you are visiting or the provider of such products or services.

We may also make some content, products and services available through our Site through cooperative relationships with third-party providers, where the brands of our provider partner appear on the Site in connection with such content, products and/or services. We may share with our provider partner any information you provide, or that is collected, in the course of visiting any pages that are made available in cooperation with our provider partner. In some cases, the provider partner may collect information from you directly, in which cases the privacy policy of our provider partner may apply to the provider partner's use of your information. The privacy policy of our provider partners may differ from ours. If you have any questions regarding the privacy policy of one of our provider partners, you should contact the provider partner directly for more information.

Be aware that we may occasionally release information about our visitors when release is appropriate to comply with law or to protect the rights, property or safety of users of the Site or the public. Please also note that as our business grows, we may buy or sell various assets. In the unlikely event that we sell some or all of our assets, or one or more of our websites

is acquired by another company, information about our users may be among the transferred assets.

HOW DO WE STORE YOUR INFORMATION?

Your information is stored at the list server that delivers this Site's electronic communications. Your information can only be accessed by those who help manage those lists in order to deliver e-mail to those who would like to receive this Site's products and communications. All of the communications that are sent to you by this Site include an unsubscribe link in them. You can remove yourself at any time from our newsletters or mailing lists by clicking on the unsubscribe link that can be found in every communication that we send you.

ACCESS AND CORRECTION

General

Please contact us if you would like to access or correct the personal information that we hold about you. We may ask you to verify your identity before processing any access or correction requests, to make sure that the personal information we hold is properly protected. Correction If you ask us to correct personal information that we hold about you, or if we are satisfied that the personal information we hold is inaccurate, out of date, incomplete, irrelevant or misleading, we will take reasonable steps to correct that information to ensure that, having regard to the purpose for which it is held, the information is accurate, up-to-date, complete, relevant and not misleading. If we correct personal information about you, and we have previously disclosed that information to another agency or organization, you may ask us to notify that other entity. If so, we will take reasonable steps to do so, unless this would be impractical or unlawful.

CROSS BORDER DISCLOSURE ACCESS AND CONSENT TO TRANSFER

By providing us with your personal information, you consent to our use of it in accordance with this policy, including the transfer of your information across international boundaries to jurisdictions anywhere in the world as permitted by local law.

For United States Users:

The United States may not have data privacy laws that are deemed to afford an equal level of protection for your personal information as those laws legislated at the direction of the European Union, Australia or geopolitical, national or regional legislative bodies. However, please be assured that we will continue to adhere to the principles stated in this policy and will make reasonable efforts to comply with applicable international, national, regional, territorial, and provincial laws in connection with any information collected through the Site. We will always endeavor to preserve the integrity, confidentiality, and security of personal information and afford such personal information reasonable level of protection.

Your California Privacy Rights: Other than as is stated by this policy, we will not share any personal information about you with outside third-parties for their direct marketing purposes to the extent prohibited by California law, unless you agree otherwise as authorized by your prior written consent.

DATA RETENTION PERIODS

We will retain your personally identifiable information for as long as your account is active, as needed to send you email communication you signed up to receive or as needed to provide you with our products and services. GENERAL AUDIENCE WEBSITE NOT DIRECTED TOWARD CHILDREN
